This piece was composed in 1971 for the children of Churchfields Junior School, South Woodford, to play on their recorders (in the key of C), when all the printed music then available was too easy for them. It has since reappeared in various guises. This version was made for the Canonbury Wind Players, and amateur group which normally played as a wind octet, but occasionally expanded with flutes, a contrabassoon, and other instruments. The flute and contra parts are an afterthought, and are ad lib.

It became traditional for the first clarinettist of the group to improvise freely during the repeated section from rehearsal letter H onwards. Other clarinettists should feel free to do likewise.
